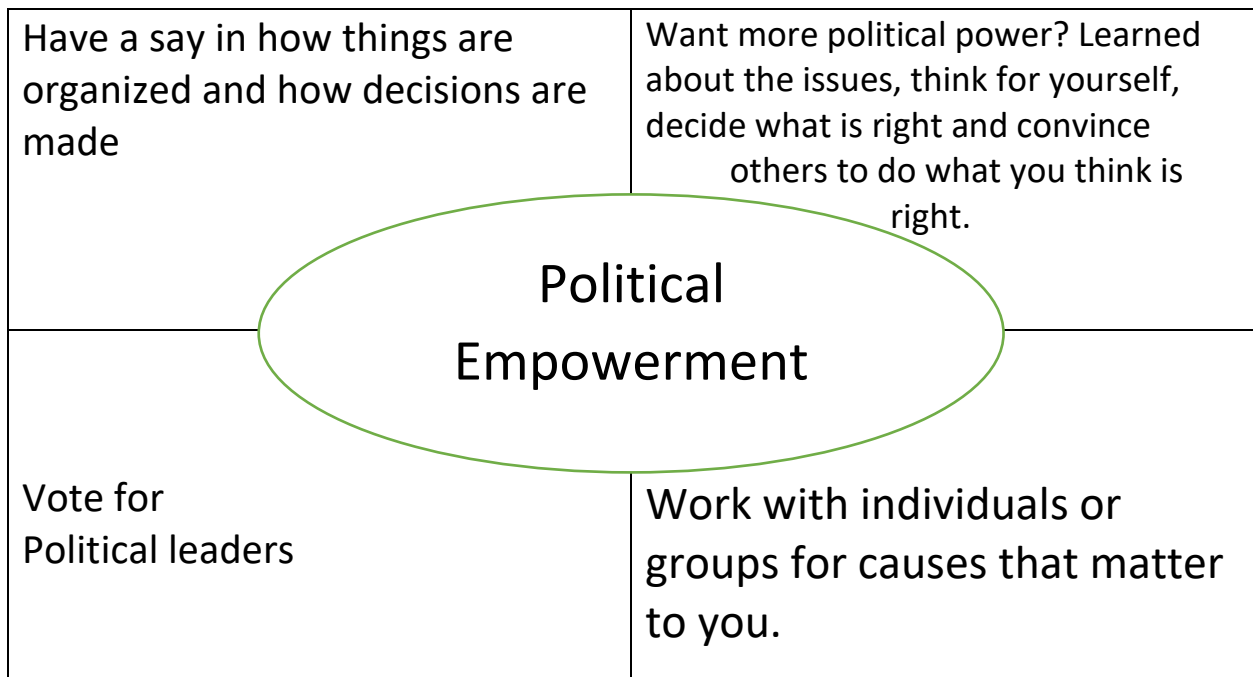
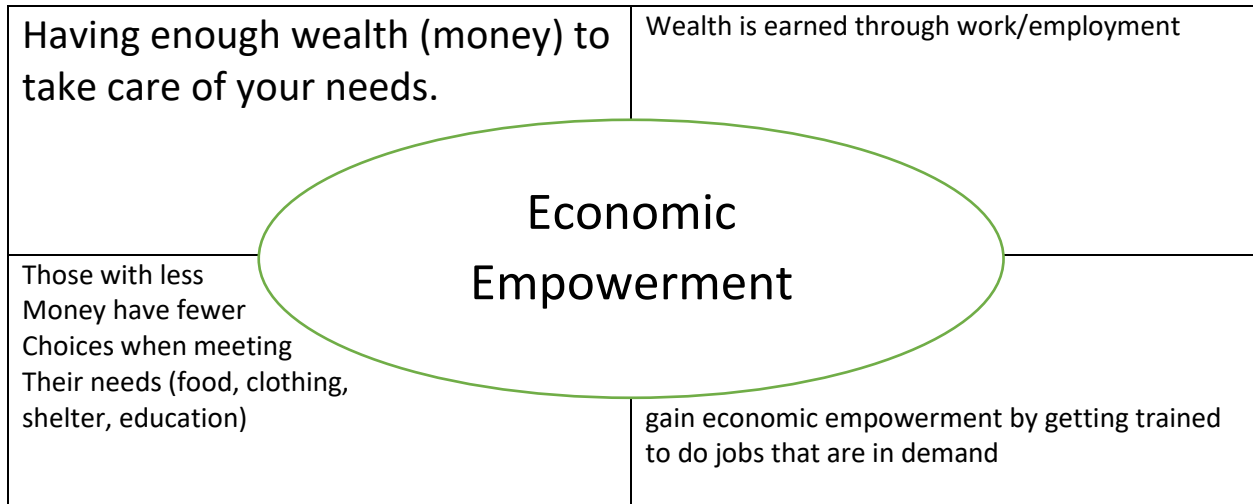





Types of Empowerment

 <p>Cultural Empowerment</p>	
Stay active in Your culture and learn all you can	Speak up if you think something or someone is being treated unfairly.

All members of society being treated fairly and equally.	Responsibilities: people in power must use their power wisely.
 <p>Societal Empowerment</p>	
Sometimes: One group will get more power – possibly because of having more wealth, being a larger group, or having more political power.	Responsibilities: Speak up if you think something unfair has happened.

Nations having the power to make decisions for itself.	Have the power to: decide to go to war (or not to go to war).
 <p>National Empowerment</p>	
They also have the power to choose how to use their natural resources.	Responsibilities: Must be fair to their citizens and other nations
They can make their own laws.
